- Superintendent Report (Kendrick Lester):
 - Student enrollment as of June 1: 86 students. Anticipated enrollment for the start of 2024-25: 83 students.
 - Average daily attendance: 93.3% for elementary and 90.5% for secondary.
 - Activities: Elementary completed their play "Peter Pan," graduation was on June 8, and the GEAR UP grant cycle has ended.
 - o Community Center updates: Ongoing work on water leaks and plans for summer maintenance.
 - Summer lunch program starts next week running weekdays the month of July except for holidays

- Athletic report: Positive numbers anticipated for fall sports

- MS Football: 10, most likely 7 based on relocation and past involvement
- Esports: 3, most likely offered as a club
